Israel and has very little contact with her.

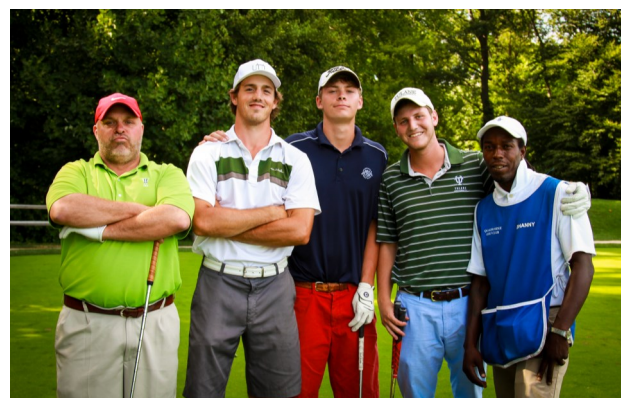

Meet CCOC's Ethan Stein

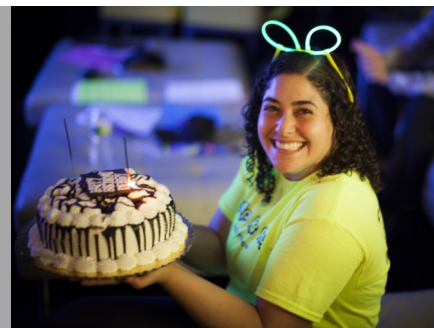
